Teens are sorting through what they believe...



8%

3 in 5 teens in the U.S. say they **never** read religious scripture on their own.

Nearly half (45%) of teens believe **all religions teach equally valid truths.** Christians are **just as likely** as non-believers to say this.

51%

While **51%** of teens surveyed self-identified as Christian, just **8%** display the beliefs and habits of a **Committed Christian**.

Nearly 6 out of 10 Christian teens we surveyed don't believe they have a responsibility to share their faith or religious beliefs with others.

2 out of every 5

teens in the U.S. claim no religion – sometimes this group is called "nones". Yet, **2 in 3** in this group would consider coming to church if someone invited them.
